Re: Visit to Harry Potter @ Warner Brother Studios – 26 November 2018

Chantry Academy recognises the importance of providing enriched experiences outside of the classroom. As such we have arranged an educational visit for Wednesday 28 November 2018 to the Warner Brothers Studio, London for Year 10 Media students.

The trip will focus on media production in preparation for the GCSE examination students will take in January 2019 on pre-production techniques. Students will attend a workshop where they will be learning about the process of “Script to Screen” and how scripts, storyboards and initial design ideas are used within film production. Afterwards students will undertake investigative activities within the Harry Potter studio tour which includes props, costumes and models from the film series.

Students will meet in Room GO8 from 8:00am in order that we can depart from school shortly after. We will be travelling by school minibus returning to school at approximately 18:00. You should make your own arrangements to collect students from school.

Students will need to be provided with a packed lunch and a small amount of spending money if they wish to purchase something in the souvenir shop. Students are permitted to attend the day in smart non-uniform and ensure they bring a suitable waterproof jacket with them in case of wet weather.

Parents should be aware that it is Academy policy that participation in a trip will be dependent on staff feeling confident that your son/daughter will behave appropriately. In particular poor behavior between now and the date of the trip is likely to result in your child being withdrawn from the trip. Your child will be expected to follow the Academy’s code of conduct at all times. It is parents’ responsibility to ensure this is clearly understood by their sons/daughters. The decision of the Principal on this matter is final.
