How to Make Bread

Ingredients

- 500g strong flour (plus extra for dusting)
- · 2 teaspoons of salt
- 7g of dried yeast
- 3 tablespoons of olive oil
- · 300ml of water

Equipment

- Mixing bowl and spoon
- · Loaf tin

Method

- 1. Preheat your oven to 220°C.
- Sieve the flour, salt and yeast into a bowl. Make a well in the centre and add the oil and water.
- Mix the wet and dry ingredients together to form a dough. Add a little more water if the mixture is stiff.
- Tip the dough out onto a lightly floured surface and knead the dough until it is smooth.
- Put the dough in a bowl, covered with cling film, for around an hour or until it has doubled in size. Knock back the dough and
